Topic description

Since January 2014, we are working with a group of 10 on a review article entitled “Structural and functional interactions between pith, parenchyma and phloem tissues define tree responses to drought stress”. In a first workshop held in January 2014 we defined the exact topic of the paper, from February to June 2014 we did a literature review and during a second workshop in July 2014, we made the outline of the manuscript so that the writing of it could start. The review wants to compile the currently existing studies regarding the anatomical and physiological patterns of phloem and parenchyma tissues in trees across gradients in short and long term drought stress conditions, and from there the definition of current research gaps and possibilities for joint research initiatives.
